(FY 08/09)

Below is a summary of the finances for the Association. For a more detailed breakdown please see the Auditors report for the year, or the full records.

Income

This year has been a good year for the association in regards to income. Income increased by 50% over the last year due to the hosting of the D. H. McKenzie (DHM) Tournament. At the end of the Financial Year 08/09 ACTFA had taken in over \$74,000 with the DHM and general ACTFA books combined. Listed below is a breakdown of the Income for FY 08/09:

Grants

The Association was lucky enough to receive 3 separate grants this FY.

The first was the Volunteers Grant from the Department of Families, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs for the sum of \$4000.00 for the purchase of a Conductive rubber piste.

The Second grant was the Operational Assistance Grant from the ACT Sport and Recreation for the amount of \$6,000.00, which included a \$2,000.00 component for the purchase of a conductive rubber piste.

The third was another grant from the ACT Sport and recreation of \$4,500.00, once again, for the purchase of a conductive rubber piste.

The end result of the grants, as you can see, is the ACT is now well setup with pistes, 3 of which are lightweight and easy to handle.

Membership

The membership of the association was very healthy this year. It beat all records from the last 5 years, and peaked at a total of 142 members.
