







## **ACT Canberra Day Fencing Tournament 2010**

#### **Competitions**

The competitions will consist of a Round Robin, followed by a Direct Elimination if time permits. The DT will announce if a Direct Elimination round will be held before the commencement of the Round Robin and the number of fencers that will progress to the Direct Elimination. The DT will confirm the running of a particular event on the 1st Mar 2009. Men's and Women's of the same level may be combined depending on numbers. (Min.of 6 fencers per event)

<sup>\*</sup> To be eligible for a Novice event, the fencer must have less than 2 years of State registration. Eligibility ceases if the fencer finishes in the top 50% of a State open, or has competed in an AFF event.
