Dress requirements: Full Breeches and Fencing Jacket Required for Opens (Min. 350n). Long pants and Fencing Jacket required for Novice Events min 350n. Masks to be min 350n. (Conductive Bib NOT required for Foil, Underplastron will be required for all events)

A check of the Masks will be required to ensure suitability for use. All weapons.
(ie. Safety checks as per national events.)





ACT Canberra Day Fencing Tournament 2012

This page is intended to assist fencers coming by car from outside of the ACT.



It details instructions from the north of Northbourne Avenue, to the venue.

1. From the *Federal Highway*, continue onto and south along *Northbourne Ave*, until you come to lights at *London Cct*. Turn **Right** onto *London Cct*.
2. Follow *London Cct* until you come to lights at *Edinburgh Ave*, turn **Right** onto *Edinburgh Ave*
3. Follow *Edinburgh Ave* until the lights for *Parkes Way*. Turn **Right** onto *Parks Way*.



4. Follow *Parkes Way* for around 15-20 minutes, (it becomes *Tuggeranong Pwy*, and then *Drakeford Dr*) until you come to lights for *Athllon Dr*. Turn **Right** onto *Athllon Dr*.

5. After driving over the Dam for the Lake, turn **Left** onto *Cowlishaw St*. The venue is now on your **Right**. Parking is available to your **Right**, either in the small carpark attached to the Stadium, or the Southern Cross car park.

Competitions

The competitions will consist of a Round Robin, followed by a Direct Elimination if time permits. The DT will announce if a Direct Elimination round will be held before the commencement of the Round Robin and the number of fencers that will progress to the Direct Elimination. The DT will confirm the running of a particular event on the 5th Mar 2012. Men's and Women's of the same level may be combined depending on numbers. (Min. of 6 fencers per event)

Safety checks for Masks will be available and required from 60 minutes before registration close for all events.

* To be eligible for a Novice event, the fencer must have less than 2 years of State registration. Eligibility ceases if the fencer finishes in the top 50% of a State open, or has competed in an AFF event.

\$25 entry fee will apply until the 26th of February. \$40 entry fee will from the 27th February 2012. Registrations will be accepted by the following methods:
