#### **Competitions**

The competitions will consist of a Round Robin, followed by a Direct Elimination if time permits. The DT will announce if a Direct Elimination round will not be held before the commencement of the Round Robin and the number of fencers that will progress to the Direct Elimination. The DT will confirm the running of a particular event on the 8<sup>th</sup> Mar 2019 and changes will be announced on the ACTFA website. Men's and Women's of the same event may be combined depending on numbers (Min of 6 fencers per event required). Times listed are close of Registration times.
