Competitions

The competitions will consist of a Round Robin, followed by a Direct Elimination if time permits. The DT will announce if a Direct Elimination round will not be held before the commencement of the Round Robin and the number of fencers that will progress to the Direct Elimination. The DT will confirm the running of the event on 2 days before the scheduled date. Men's and Women's of the same event may be combined depending on numbers (Min.of 4 fencers per event required).

Events will be mixed if there are less than 4 fencers for a Gender.

Roll Call for all events will be 7:00pm on the day of the event.

Roll Call is the close of registrations as above. All fencers MUST be at the venue at this time to be included in the event. Any issues call 0418 612 915 on the day.

Fencing will commence as soon as possible after Registration Closes.
