**All Fencers must be affiliated through their state association to the AFF. Note: Fencers affiliated as beginners can only compete in Novice Events**

Cost for Open events will be: Early Bird (up to and including 24 May 2025) - \$20\* per event

Normal (25 May 2025 to 29 May 2025) – \$30\* per event

Late Entry (After 29 May 2025) - \$50\* per event (\*plus online fees)

Dress requirements for Open and Veteran events:

Full Breeches, long socks, and Fencing Jacket Required (Min. 350N)

Masks to be min 350N. **Conductive Bib is required for Foil.**

For Novice events:

tracksuit or breeches with long socks are acceptable. (no shorts)

**Underplastrons will be required for ALL events**

### **Competitions**

The competitions will consist of a Round Robin, followed by a Direct Elimination if time permits. The DT will announce if a Direct Elimination round will not be held before the commencement of the Round Robin and the number of fencers that will progress to the Direct Elimination.

The DT will confirm the running of a particular event on the 30<sup>th</sup> May 2025 and changes will be announced on the ACTFA website. Men's and Women's of the same event may be combined depending on numbers (Min of 4 fencers per event required). Times listed are close of Registration times.
